Some details of the linguistics B.A. track

- **Undergraduate English majors at UD may decide to take courses mainly in linguistics in the final year of the B.A. Program.**
- **As a student of this track, you will study language from different perspectives, including research in the fields of syntax, semantics, child language, computational linguistics, sociolinguistics and second language acquisition.**
- **Students must complete 9 electives from the list of courses below. No course is compulsory. The courses on offer vary each year depending on student interest and our faculty's teaching schedules. Classes meet once a week for two hours.**
- **Syntax and morphology, Language acquisition, Semantics and pragmatics, Computers and language, Varieties of English, Introduction to language teaching methods, Topics in language research, The study of sounds, The social and discourse aspects of language, Evaluation and assessment, Child language, The science of words, Advanced topics in language studies, Experimental linguistics, Topics in digital humanities**

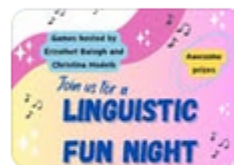
