Courses -2025/2026 fall semester

Grammar in Context

The course aims to develop students' understanding and skills of English grammar with the help of practical and authentic written and audio texts and materials. Beyond the theoretical understanding of selected grammar issues, students are encouraged to challenge the ideas presented and to suggest, based on experience, their own interpretation of the issues in question. Throughout the course, students will also be asked to contribute to the lessons with their interpretation of the theories discussed and apply these in practice.

Language acquisition

The purpose of the course is to familiarize students with some notions in the field of language acquisition both from a theoretical and a practical point of view. The topics of the course include the issues of research methods, the linguistics and non-linguistics aspects of language acquisition in general, and of first, second and third language acquisition in particular. Students will be required to conduct small-scale tasks, exercises and studies throughout the course to demonstrate that they understand and are able to apply their theoretical knowledge in practice.
