- **7 foundational courses, electives, thesis, final exam**

E.g.: Syntax, Semantics, Argument Structure, Language Acquisition, Computational Linguistics, Pragmatics, The Social and Discourse Aspects of Language, Empirical Linguistics, Perspectives on the Lexicon, Issues in Bilingualism, Psycholinguistics and Neurolinguistics, Current issues in language studies, etc. - courses offered vary each semester depending on student demand and staff availability
